Footpaths & Roads:

Lodge road footpath - slow progress with contractors preparing the site. We are promised the path will be ready by beginning of September.

A Footpath over the motorway bridge between Hurst (Dinton Pastures Entrance) and Winnersh, following a number of meetings, WBC has agreed to look at the possibility of another footpath on the opposite side of the road to the existing footpath. This will avoid residents crossing the busy road at the entrance of the country park, I will keep you updated with progress.

A321 road surface: I've had a number of complaints regarding the condition of the A321 particularly approaching the Forest Road junction. The stretch from Cantley Park is due to be completely resurfaced in September.

Play Area – School Road: The Parish Council have planned a number of new/replacement items for our play area, we hope to place the order this month for installation during October.
