Road Works

Works requiring road restrictions shall take place on **22nd January 2018**

Hogmoor Lane/Poplar Lane, between its junctions with Hinton Road and A321 Broadwater Lane. The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Hinton Road and A321 Broadwater Lane, or by this route in reverse.

Works requiring this restriction shall take place on **23rd January 2018**

Pound Lane/Broadcommon Road, between its respective junctions with Nelsons Lane. The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Nelsons Lane.

Works requiring this restriction shall take place on **23rd January 2018**

Broadcommon Road, between its junctions with Nelson Lane and A321 Wokingham Road. The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Nelsons Lane and A321 Wokingham Road.

M4 Junctions 8/9 to 10 Straight Mile Bridge – Maintenance Scheme

Essential repairs to the bridge which carries The Straight Mile over the M4, to ensure it remains in a safe and serviceable condition is currently scheduled to start on **Thursday 1 February 2018** and is expected to take up-to two weeks to complete.

In order to carry out the work as efficiently and safely as possible, we will fully close the bridge over the M4 overnight (Monday to Friday only); a clearly signed diversion will be in place via The Straight Mile, B3018 and Forest Road. Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles only.
