Plan ahead Bank Holiday Rail travellers told

From Saturday 5 to Monday 7 May, Network Rail will carry out upgrade work between Maidenhead, and Hayes & Harlington, with the work extending from Hayes & Harlington to London Paddington on Sunday 6 May.

Travelling on Saturday 5 or Monday 7 May?

- Buses will replace trains between Maidenhead and Hayes & Harlington
- Long-distance services will be diverted around the affected area into London Paddington, adding up to an hour to journey times from Bristol/South Wales, and an hour and a half from Devon/Cornwall
- Services between Cheltenham Spa and London Paddington will start-terminate at Swindon
- Suburban stopping services that would normally operate into London Paddington will terminate at Maidenhead
- Services from London Paddington to Hayes & Harlington and Heathrow Airport will continue to run
- Tickets will be accepted on South Western Railway services from Reading and Windsor & Eton Riverside, as well as on Chiltern Railways services from Oxford

Travelling on Sunday 6 May?

- Buses will replace trains between Maidenhead and Ealing Broadway with no GWR or Heathrow services into London Paddington
- Long-distance services will be diverted to London Marylebone adding up to an hour to journey times from Bristol/South Wales and 90 minutes from Devon/Cornwall
- Services between Cheltenham Spa and London Paddington will start/terminate at Swindon
- Tickets will be accepted on South Western Railway services from Reading and Windsor & Eton Riverside, as well as on Chiltern Railways services from Oxford
