

Planning Update

Government reversal of plans for 1,635 houses/year in WBC

As you may have seen in the <u>press</u> just before Christmas, the government has reversed it's plans to increase the number of houses required in the WBC borough from 789 to 1635 houses per year. <u>Thank you</u> to everyone who joined the campaign against the increase.

Target now back to 789 houses/year

There is no certainty as yet where these houses will go. The Council is once again reviewing the options. We will of course you keep you updated as more information becomes available.
