



Land East of Lodge Road & Tape Lane Campaign Against Proposal for 200 Houses

The HVS is working as a member of A JOINT TEAM with Councillors from Hurst Parish Council and representatives from The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group and The Protect Hurst Action Group on a campaign objecting to the Outline Planning Application for 200 houses on fields between Tape Lane and Lodge Road.

The JOINT TEAM met on 2nd March and agreed to hold **DROP IN MEETINGS** at **St Nicholas School Hall on Friday 11th March 5.00pm to 7.00pm and Saturday 12th March 10.00am. to 12 Noon for all residents to attend** and to also produce flyers and banners to publicise these meetings, which HVS has paid for.
