## Open Letter

**Re: Planning application 211532 – Proposed 4 dwellings on land between Sawpit Road and School Road**

Hurst Village Society has been formally aware of this application now since the beginning of May. The members of PHAG are concerned that as this application is outside the development limit of Hurst and that the HVS statement on their website is **'The Primary concern of the Society is to protect the physical environment and maintain the rural aspect of the area'**, that HVS have yet to announce their stance on this application.

Hurst Village Society objected to the recent Lodge Road application for 5 dwellings, which was also outside the development limit and has many similarities to this application. This was comprehensively dismissed twice by the Planning Inspectors. Can we presume that for the same reasons HVS will be objecting to this application?

Considerable consternation has been raised by our members, many of whom are also members of the HVS, as to why there has so far been no comment or campaign to object to this planning application from HVS and why there has been no public communication from HVS regarding this application?
